## MKM Precision, LLC Range Rules \*\*\*\* SAFETY FIRST \*\*\*\*

Always be aware of your location on the Range and practice safe gun handling.

Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction toward the back of the berm.

Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.

Keep the gun unloaded until ready to shoot.

Everyone at the range is responsible for safety. If you see someone acting in an unsafe manner, call a cease fire and caution that person.

Members are allowed to use the range side by side to go down range. Personal vehicles are not permitted downrange for any reason. If the range side by side is unavailable, then personal vehicles may be allowed downrange by permission.

Member shooting areas are anywhere across the main range firing line and the 600 yard range firing line. The yellow gate range is closed to members and used for events only or as authorized by MKM staff. Going down range on the 600 yard range is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

No GUESTS are allowed on MKM property without approval. Approval by Ken Sanoski will be given for each visit. Approval for a one-day Guest visit does not give a blanket approval for the year. Approved Guests are required to complete a waiver prior to arrival at the range. Guest fees shall be paid upon arrival and left in the drop box at the range. Failure to get pre-approval for your Guests will result in immediate termination of membership privileges without refund.

Members are responsible for the actions of their Guests while on the Range. Violation of club safety rules and/or inappropriate action by your guest may result in your membership being revoked without refund.

Everyone on the range is required to use eye and hearing protection. This includes shooters, spectators, and children of all ages.

Use of the Range for the purpose of structured training (i.e. CCW classes, tactical training, firearms demos, etc.) is prohibited.

If there are issues with any of the individual shooting ranges on the complex please contact MKM staff.

Range hours are from SUN RISE to SUN SET 7 days a week.

All Federal, state, and local firearm laws must be obeyed.

All members are required to have their membership cards with them when they are at the range. All members are required to show their membership card anytime they are asked to, and each member has the right to ask to see any other member's card as well.

The Range gate is to be kept locked by members at all times. Make certain that the padlock has been snapped into place and the combination scrambled. Don't forget to lock the gate once you leave. Do not share the combination with non-members.

Never walk or drive past any closed gates, cables, safety cones or barricades without checking to see if that area is a live-fire area.

When going down range to paint steel targets make all ranges cease fire and use posted "downrange procedures" for each range. This requires visual and verbal confirmation that all firearms are clear and other members are off the firing line. No handling of firearms or ammunition while members are down range.

Shooting may only commence, when it is verified that there is no person down range and the range is determined to be secure.

MKM Shooting Complex is a "cold range". All firearms are to be kept in a safe and empty condition until on the firing line. Chamber flags are mandatory and to be used by everyone while at the Range.

Shoot from authorized firing points only. Do not shoot into neighboring properties.

<u>Do not engage ANY steel targets on ANY range with ANY centerfire rifle closer than 300 yards</u>. The steel inside 300 yards is for rimfire only. Anyone caught shooting the rimfire targets with a centerfire rifle will have their range membership terminated, and no refund will be given.

50 BMG, 338 Lapua or similar size large bore calibers are not permitted on the range.

Do not move, relocate, or change targets from their locations.

Shooting at rocks or any other inappropriate targets that cause ricochets or may start a fire is prohibited.

Shooting any flammable or exploding material is prohibited. This includes Tannerite or any other similar binary compounds without approval from MKM staff.

Hunting, fishing and shooting at any wildlife is strictly prohibited everywhere on the MKM Shooting Complex.

Tracer, incendiary and armor-piercing ammunitions are prohibited. This includes "green-tip" or any steel core bullets – i.e. bulk military ammo is often steel core – use on paper targets only.

Never shoot at MKM property or structures. Any props or equipment which you might use, are to be used only for the purpose for which they were designed, including tables, chairs, benches, trash cans, equipment storage boxes and target holders.

No alcohol is to be present or consumed by anyone, anywhere on range property. Any condition resulting in the shooter's impairment will result in immediate termination of membership privileges without refund.

Smoking is prohibited anywhere on the firing line; smokers must fully extinguish their butts and place them into the trash cans.

Members are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and Guests. Deposit trash in the appropriate trash cans or pack it up and take it home. Keep your range clean! This includes brass, shells, rimfire brass and any and all casings.

Absolutely no sale of firearms or ammunition is permitted on range property.

Any members under the age of 18 years must be under the constant supervision of an adult member.

The MKM Shooting Complex may be closed to members anytime we are running large matches, training classes, or performing maintenance. Members are responsible for checking the schedule on our facebook page.

MKM may refuse anyone the right to shoot and may order anyone to leave the range to enforce the range rules and preserve the safety of the range or the safety of its members. Repeat or gross offenders will have their membership revoked without refund. It is our intent to provide a first rate, semi-private facility for the serious marksmen.
